

DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR FINANCIAL AID ASSISTANCE

Documents Needed for FAFSA Filling

Fall 2023-Summer 2024 - Bring 2021 information for the 2023–2024 school year. Fall 2024-Summer 2025 - Bring 2022 information for the 2024–2025 school year.

When applying for FAFSA - financial aid you will need to bring:

Your 2021 and/or 2022 Federal Income Tax Return and W2s (signed) <u>and</u>

If married, your spouse's signed 2021 and/or 2022 Income Tax Return.

Your parents signed 2021 and/or 2022 Income Tax Return and W2s if the answer is "no" to ALL of these questions:

- You were born before 1/1/2000? (2023-2024 FAFSA)
- You were born before 1/1/2001? (2024-2025 FAFSA)
- Are you married?
- Are you working on a Master's or Doctorate degree?
- Are you a veteran of the US armed forces?
- Are you currently serving active duty in the US armed forces?
- Do you have children who receive **51%** of their financial support from you?
- Do you have dependents who receive 51% of their financial support from you?
- Are both your parents deceased or were you a ward of the court or in foster care? *
- Did someone other than your parents have legal guardianship of you? *
- Are you or were you an emancipated minor as
 determined by a court? *

- Child Support
 - An annual statement of the total amount received in 2021 and/or 2022.
 - An annual statement of the total amount paid in 2021 and/or 2022.
- Welfare Benefits
 - An annual statement of the total benefits received in 2021 and/or 2022.
- Social Security
 - An annual statement of the total amount received in 2021 and/or 2022.
 - Bring a statement for each person in the household who received benefits.
- * Legal Guardianship, Foster Care, or an Emancipated Minor
 - Bring signed copies of the legal court documents for proof of legal guardianship, foster care, or an emancipated minor.

(Have the person who received the benefits sign the documents.)
