

• ACT or ACCUPLACER Test Scores within the Past 5 Years We offer the Accuplacer testing for FREE! Contact the Testing Center at 870-762-3104 to arrange for testing.

 Official High School Transcript or GED Scores High school transcripts are only considered official after graduation. The transcript must have your graduation date and GPA.

• Official College Transcripts for Any Other College(s) You Have Attended If you have ever been enrolled in a college other than ANC, please contact the college(s) to have them send your official transcript.



STEP 1 - ACCESSING YOUR ANC EMAIL

A. To set up your school email, go to <u>http://mail.google.com</u> and add a new account. Log in with the following:

STEP 2 - ACCESSING BRIGHTSPACE

Brightspace is where you will access your classes and complete assignments at Arkansas Northeastern College. To get to Brightspace, go to <u>www.anc.edu</u> and press the Brightspace Login link.

Your Brightspace is linked to your ANC email, so you will automatically be logged into Brightspace!

STEP 3 - COMPLETE BRIGHTSPACE ORIENTATION

The Brightspace orientation course is designed to get you familiar with the platform. You will be guided through videos, lessons, and assignments as if this was an actual graded class. Don't worry, it's not for a grade!

The orientation course is located on the home screen with your other courses. Follow each module carefully. It will never expire, so you can always reference it if you need a refresher later in the semester.

The ANC Portal or myANC

What can you do on myANC?

- Review your schedule
- Make payments on your account
- Some classes use the portal instead of Brightspace

To log in to **myANC**:

- Type your 9-digit Student ID into the Username box
- Type the last four digits of your SSN in the password box.
 - If the last four digits of your SSN begin with a zero, drop it and begin with the next non-zero digit.
- Your student ID is listed in your welcome letter.

You can call student services at 870-838-2955 if you do not know your number.



DROP VS. WITHDRAW

Know the Difference

DROP

When you unenroll from a class BEFORE the refund period.

The last day to drop for a 100% refund is January 19, 2024, at 4:30 PM! **WITHDRAW**

When you unenroll from a class AFTER the refund period.

The last day to withdraw from classes is April 12, 2024.

• You are still responsible for the class charges, but your transcript will show a W for withdrawal.

IF YOU NEED TO DROP OR WITHDRAW, DO NOT JUST STOP COMING TO CLASS!!



Students who do not withdraw will be assigned a grade of "F" in the class, and their GPA will be affected.

- Courses dropped during the first ten days of a Fall/Spring semester or the first five days of classes of a Summer term will not appear on the student's academic record.
- Courses dropped after the 23 first ten days of classes will carry a grade of "W" and will appear on the student's academic record.

*If a student wishes to drop or withdraw from a course, they must contact their advisor to start the drop process so that the Registrar, Student Financial Aid Office, Business Office, and Veteran's Aid Assistant (if applicable) are notified.
