In 2001, she completed her Associate in Arts from Arkansas Northeastern College, then Mississippi County Community College. A mother of two sons (Larricus and Andrew) and one daughter (Brittani), Pacey always knew the importance of education and how enriching higher knowledge can improve your life. As a non-traditional student, Pacey continued to work while attending classes and eventually completed her BSB/ACC and MBA/ACC from the University of Phoenix.

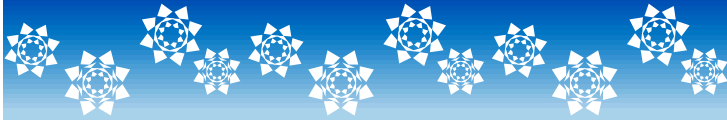

Our local radio station (96.3FM) and KAIT TV Channel 8, Jonesboro, will be the two notified first because they are the fastest and easiest of our media to contact during inclement weather. For those of you who signed up for text messaging on the portal, you will receive a text message on the status of the closing.
