Call for ANC Japan Ambassadors

The ANC Foundation, with the generous support of Yamato Kogyo Co. Ltd., is searching for this year's Arkansas Northeastern College Ambassadors to Japan. Two ambassadors will be selected, with each receiving an all-expense paid, two-week trip to Japan. The trip is scheduled for May 18 through June 2, 2013.

This once in a lifetime opportunity is a great way to not only learn about another culture, but also share our culture with others.

The ANC Ambassadors to Japan program began in 1996 and allows the students to experience the Japanese culture. They visit cities such as Himeji, Osaka, Tokyo, Hiroshima, and Kyoto. While they stay in hotels and the Yamato Kogyo dormitory, they also spend a week in the home of a Japanese family where they are immersed into the everyday life of the Japanese.

To qualify for consideration, applicants must be between the ages of 18 and 24, enrolled in at least nine hours at the time of applying, be degree-seeking at ANC, have completed a minimum of 15 and a maximum of 45 credit hours by the end of the Spring 2013 semester, and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0. Students must also be prepared to provide personal spending money, proof of insurance,

and obtain a passport. Those interested must complete the application process, including a 250 word essay, by March 1, 2013.

Application forms are available at the receptionist station upstairs in the Briggs/Sebaugh Wellness Center. Please return applications to the same place by March 1, 2013.

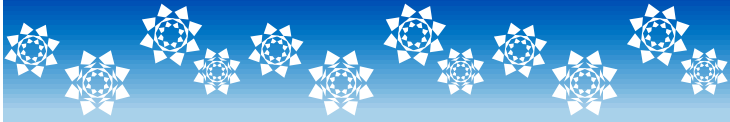
