# Preview Day Draws Over 350 Prospective Students



Students from area schools filled the Adams/Vines Recital Hall to capacity last Friday, as they convened on campus to learn about ANC's educational programs and related career opportunities.

ANC's annual Preview Day for high school students was held last week on the Blytheville Main Campus. Approximately 300 students from Northeast Arkansas and Southeast Missouri were in attendance.

The day was filled with information regarding programs of study at ANC and related career opportunities. Students were able to learn about the Associate of Arts Degree and its transferability, the Associate of Applied Science Degree options, the Allied Health Division, education programs, and various occupational areas of study, as well as Steel Industry Technology and Aviation Maintenance and the related internship programs of each.

Topics highlighted were expectations of the program, possible job opportunities after graduation, what qualities lean toward success in the program, and degree plans. Sessions were conducted by the deans and faculty from the various departments, and were available for students to ask questions and explore educational possibilities.
