KIPP Students visit ANC Science Lab



KIPP Blytheville College Preparatory School requested an ANC site visit and field outing for 27 of their 5th grade students. These students had been studying scientific method, and on September 28, they had the opportunity to put their abilities to the test. Their experiment consisted of a water filtration system. This filtration system was to be built out of an inverted 2 Liter bottle, sand, pebbles, soil, and cotton balls.

The students followed the scientific method and designed their own systems, each one different from the others. The teams decided which substance would be used first, second, third, and fourth. Each team decided how much of each substance was to be used. They measured the amount of water going into the system and measured the amount that filtered through the system; comparisons between the quality of the water going in and coming out were also observed and discussed.

It was an exciting day for these promising young students, and an opportunity for ANC to host the future leaders of our community.
