Blytheville Art Students Display Work at ANC

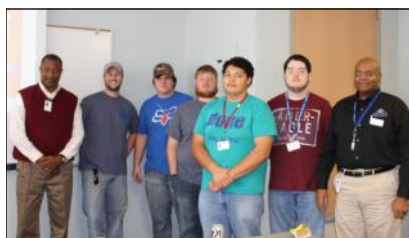

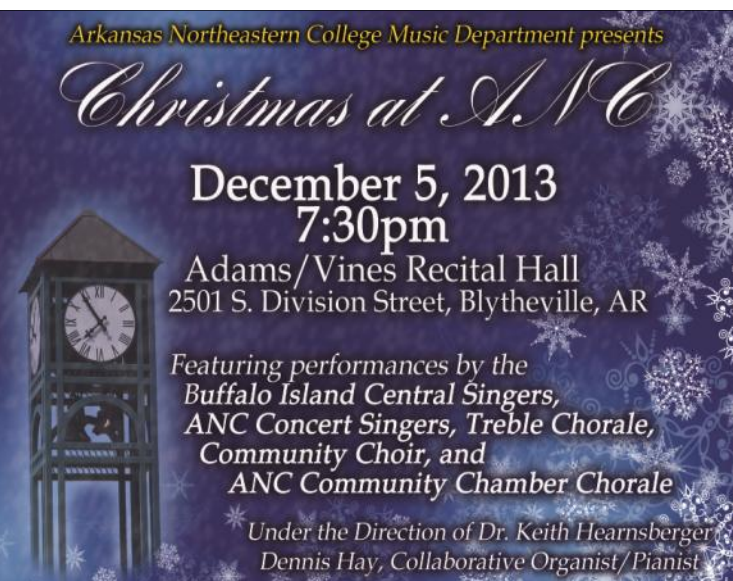
